Transfer aids	(Slings, Hoists, Transfer belts, turning and seating disks)
Pressure Care	(cushions)
Mobility	(Careports, ramps, walking frames)
Furniture	(Recliners, kitchen trolleys, Static chairs, around chair and overbed tables)
Daily aids	(Nebulisers, cup holders with modhose mounts)
Communications	(Jellybean switches, remote call bells, modhose mounts, iPads, Etran boards)
Bedroom	(Mattress overlays, Mattresses & Alternating Pressure Mattresses, Beds, Bed extensions, Safety sides, Pillow and body wedges, Sheepskin, bedside commodes, bed sticks)
